Despite its idyllic setting in the shadows of the Estrella Mountains and seclusion from the surrounding metropolis, this community is ravaged by society's most menacing ills. MVCS provides a haven where young, vulnerable, and impressionable children can experience education the way it should be free from guns, violence, drugs, profanity, graffiti, bullying and stereotypical labels. It provides its students a safe, stable, caring, and nurturing environment in an atmosphere of excellence. MVCS serves as an incubator for students' dreams and a connection to God who is able to make them come true.



As the students matriculate, cultural and biblical instruction are woven seamlessly into their daily activities. Inclusion of the families in the many school field trips gives the students and families The interaction builds relationships, strengthens families and the community.

While MVCS has an enduring and compelling history, its mission is ongoing and far from complete.
